### Community Persecutor – Sharla Jackson

Antoniell Davis and Delvecchio Collins were convicted February, 20th of burglary and false imprisonment for the August 18, 2011 burglary at 180 Jackson Street.

A woman called 911 when she saw neighbor's door being kicked in by two males later identified as the defendants, Delvicchio Collins and Antoniell Davis. Officer Parent responded and spotted the defendants going behind one of the houses off Irwin Street. Officer Szutor noticed the basement door of the house at 383 Irwin Street was broken and when he looked inside he saw the defendants and an elderly gentleman, who stated he was lying down when the defendants kicked in his door. The Victim Allen stated the defendants frightened him when they kicked in his door. The Victim Allen stated the Defendants offered him \$50 to be quiet and not tell the police. The Defendants told the Victim Allen not to open the door if the police came to his residence and they asked him for a change of clothing. A laptop computer and 60 inch flat screen television were stolen during the burglary. The stolen property was recovered on the apartment's property.

Each defendant was sentenced to 10 years to serve in prison.

### Homicide Canvass

- On Wednesday, February 8 at 3:45 PM, the Chair of Public Safety, Dorthey Hurst, participated in the Homicide Unit Tactical Neighborhood Canvass for the homicide that occurred at 633 Parkway Dr., at the Bedford Pines Apartments.
- At the briefing, community members were assigned to a homicide detective, and went door to door with that detective to assure residents that the community supports them, and to send the message that the community is committed to improving public safety. We were given flyers to hand out with the detectives.
- Other APD units also participated in this canvass, including the APEX unit, the COPS unit, the Gang Unit, Mounted Patrol and others. These Tactical Neighborhood Canvasses have made a significant impact on information developed during the investigation on past homicide cases. They also can reveal information about other open cases.

### Zone 5 & 6

- #1 issue in both zones continues to be car break-ins. Half of the victims are visitors who are unfamiliar with the risks of leaving items exposed in cars in an urban environment.

- Incident reported in the parking lot at Jack's Pizza on Highland Ave. last month is still unsolved. Trying to locate an individual (female) believed to be involved, but the victims do not appear willing to pursue prosecution if located.

## Zone 6- Major John Dalton

- 12 Officers working Day & Evening shifts (Day 3 Officers & 1 Supervisor; Evening 6 Officers & 2 Supervisors) in O4W, Auburn Ave & Blvd,
- Boulevard precinct will be located in the vicinity of the Atlanta Medical Center (AMC) Emergency Entrance.
- The precinct will not have specific manned hours, but is collaborating with security at AMC and will respond as needed
- 90 drug arrests in the last 30 days
- Responding to a question on length of time offenders spend in jail; "non-violent felons on average do not receive long jail terms unless a weapon is involved in the crime."
- APD is negotiating with Wingate Properties for the proposed booking office located at Boulevard and Angier in the Bedford-Pines housing development
