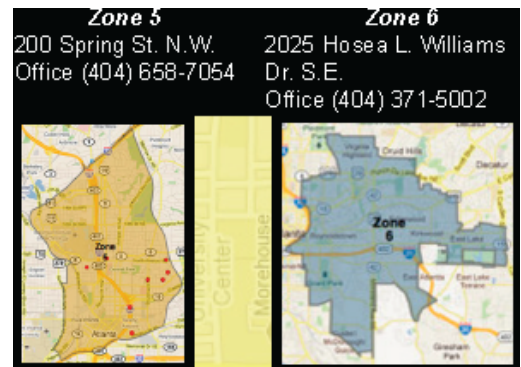

**911 Update**

- New Intern Director – Brent Schierbaum. Will be Deputy Director once a Director has been hired
- If you see suspicious behavior, example someone that you think is breaking on a car or if you see cars that has been broken into, a Police car should be dispatched. Always ask for a supervisor if you think your request is not being handled.
- Gate Codes can be added to the 911 data base. You can have your management company send the information to [dschierbaum@atlantaga.gov](mailto:dschierbaum@atlantaga.gov). The information will stay in the database for 12 months.
- The gate codes will also be viewable in the Police system on a call
- Beltline is now a street in the 911 system

**Smart 911**

**Why do I have to update or confirm my Smart911 information every 6 months?**

It is critical that emergency responders have the most current information in order to provide the fastest and most accurate response at your time of emergency. In some cases, having outdated information can send responders to an incorrect location or with incorrect details on the person in need.

**How long will my information remain available to Smart911?**

Your information will remain in Smart911 until you delete your account. However your Safety Profile is only active and available to 9-1-1 for six months after you log in to your account. If your account does not show activity by way of logging in for a period over 6 months your Safety Profile will be suspended and no information will be delivered to 9-1-1. You can reactivate your account simply by [logging in using your User ID and Password](#).

## PredPol

- Predicts crime in real time
- Complements officers intuition
- Delivers reports on paper, to smartphones, or to a tablet
- 500' x 500' place based boxes
- Specific to crime type
- Specific to shifts
- Will be deployed in Zone 6 & 4

## Precise

- The technology predicts where crimes are likely to occur in place-based prediction boxes as small as 500 feet by 500 feet. Officers are briefed at roll call on the highest-probability “hot spots” for that day and devote extra attention to those areas—as much as fifteen minutes every two hours.
- In contrast to technology that analyzes and maps past crime for some hints at the future—a kind of “rear view mirror” policing—PredPol tells law enforcement what is coming.
- Traditional mapping tools are calibrated less frequently, rely on humans to recognize patterns, and allocate resources based on past crimes rather than predicted future offenses.
