



NOTICE OF ROADS AFFECTED BY 5K

This year's SweetWater 420 Fest 5K Road Race will take place in and around Centennial Olympic Park (COP). This is the 10th anniversary of the race which takes place on Saturday, April 19th at 9 AM. Packet pick-up will take place starting at 7:00 AM at in COP in Centennial Plaza (near the fountains). Please visit <http://sweetwater420fest5k.com/> and click on VOLUNTEER to get involved. This year's race will feature a new course which begins on Centennial Olympic Park Drive near the intersection of Andrew Young International Blvd. All lanes of Centennial Olympic Park Drive will be shut down between Andrew Young International Blvd and Nassau Street NW from 8 AM to approximately 9:15 AM. In addition, the following roads will be affected:

- Southbound lane of Centennial Olympic Park Drive from Nassau St NW to Marietta St NW
- Northwest bound lane of Marietta St NW from Centennial Olympic Park Drive to Means St NW
- Northbound lane of Means St NW from Marietta St to Tech Pkwy NW
- Eastbound lane of Tech Pkwy NW from Means St NW to North Avenue NW
- Southbound lane of Luckie St NW from North Avenue NW to Hunnicutt St NW
- Eastbound lane of Hunnicutt St NW from Luckie St NW to Centennial Olympic Park Drive
- Southbound lane of Centennial Olympic Park Drive from Hunnicutt St NW to Marietta St NW
- Northwest bound lane of Marietta St NW from Centennial Olympic Park Drive to Andrew Young International Blvd NW

The race will finish on Centennial Olympic Park Drive at Andrew Young International Blvd NW and all of the runners will congregate in Centennial Olympic Park near the fountains. Please come join the fun as a volunteer or spectator. Hang around for the festivities, beer and music as the second day of Sweet-water 420 Fest begins.
